

How to? Removal for Vinyl Graphics, Striping, Decals, and Lettering

Supplies You Will Need



Environment Recommendations

The surface temperature should range from 10°C to 30°C to achieve the best removal results. Removal of vinyl graphics outside the suggested temperature range of 10°C to 30°C decrease the ability of the vinyl and adhesive to remove. Outdoor or Indoor conditions are appropriate for removal

Heated or Cold Removal?

Heat is significantly recommended when removing vinyl graphics, as when applied it is able to soften the graphic and allow it to become more resistant to cracking/crumbling when removing, as well heat will allow the vinyl to release 10x more easily then attempting the removal process at room temperature.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 1



Wash the surface thoroughly with Windex or a Surface cleaner to remove any dirt or debris that may get caught under your razor blade when starting the lifting of the vinyl graphic and glue removal process. This will ensure that no damage or scratches are caused to your glass or paint.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 2



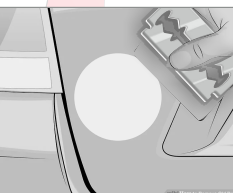
Start by heating the graphics edges and gently lift the vinyl edge with a razor blade. This will allow for a strong starting point to which the vinyl can be further peeled off its surface with a highly reduced chance of cracking vs. picking at it with your finger nail.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 3



After step 2 is repeated until your decal is fully removed, you may notice that glue residue is left over. No need to worry as now you will want to spray and really rub in the glue remover with a rag or paper towel. This will allow for the adhesive to release and become soft.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 4



Once you have rubbed your glue remover in, grab your clean razor blade and start breaking up and scraping the glue into a pile. If it is taking a few passes, repeat step 2 as some of the surface glue may not be fully saturated with the remover.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 5



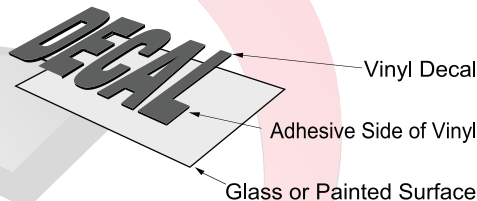
Repeat Steps 1-4 until all glue is removed and the glue remover surface is diluted and cleaned with Windex or surface cleaner.

EASY REMOVAL STEP 6



Although obvious, it is important to wash your hands immediately after to prevent any glue from solidifying or any of the glue remover from damaging your hands.

Vinyl Removal Definitions



Vinyl Decal:
The actual vinyl graphic/stripping/decal or lettering that is being removed.

Adhesive Side of Vinyl:
The sticky/adhesive side of the vinyl graphic that needs to be removed.

Glass or Paint Surface
The delicate surface you are looking to protect while performing removal.
